I was fortunate to be a part of Central Georgia Health System while it enjoyed many of its finest moments, including the highest skilled clinicians, the most dedicated staff, the best leadership team, and a most committed cadre of donors and volunteers. It is impossible to select one moment, person, procedure or structure. It has all been a wonderful journey for me.

There is, however, one phenomenon which stands out and which transcends my career. In 1998, the same year I began my tenure with The Medical Center of Central Georgia, "six degrees of separation" became a popular phrase. Everyone was enthralled

by the thought of linking all mankind through six or less friends. Over the decades, countless mathematicians, statisticians, sociologists and psychologists have sought the exact number of degrees. In fact there is a term for this measurement: collaboration distance. For me what stands out most is not the calculation of collaboration distance, rather the concept of collaboration closeness. The measure of connectedness and partnerships which has spanned my years at MCCG and Central Georgia Health System is miraculous. We, the fortunate beneficiaries, are connected through our health system by much less than six degrees. We are a family and a community, the spirit of which I shall treasure and carry with me always.

I bid my friends and colleagues farewell in the literal sense. May you not only "fare well" but may you "fare excellently." On behalf of myself and my family, we will always treasure our membership in the Central Georgia Health System family and we shall remain connected forever.

It has been an absolute pleasure to work with and among you. My memories are blessings I shall always hold dear.

Celebrating 25 Years of Visionary Leadership

There isn't a single moment Ethel Cullinan points to as emblematic during her tenure as President and Chief Executive Officer of Medcen Community Health Foundation, rather a collection of happenings that led her to the vision she began to lay out over two decades ago.

When Cullinan was named CEO in 1991, she noticed a collective lack of understanding from the central Georgia community of the world-class services provided by Central Georgia Health System and the primary non-profit entity under its umbrella: The Medical Center of Central Georgia. But over the next 21 years, Cullinan helped change that mindset by fostering with an unrivaled enthusiasm the hospital's value to the community.

"My vision was to have the central Georgia community truly appreciate the jewel we have in Macon – a world-class hospital," Cullinan, 67, said. "I didn't want people to see it as just a community hospital or some place to go when they couldn't go anywhere else, but that they actually chose to have their care here. That's always been my vision."

Not surprisingly, as the community's perception of the hospital improved, so, too, were there tangible changes. Medcen held a corpus of \$5 million when Cullinan took the helm; its principal today is over \$60 million, with another \$25 million given to support MCCG and the community during her leadership.

"Whether it's a donation of a dollar or ten million dollars, it means that a person cares about the hospital," she said. "We've raised a lot of money over the time I've been here, but we can't raise money if people don't believe in the entity in which you're asking them to invest."

Cullinan has built countless bridges of goodwill and understanding between MCCG and the community.

She will retire on March 30, leaving behind a legacy that includes Medcen support of these major projects: Ronald McDonald House, Peyton Anderson Health Education Center, Community Health Works, The Children's Hospital, fourth floor Medical Intensive Care Unit, W.T. Anderson Health Clinic, Albert J. Luce, Jr. Heart Institute and Pine Pointe Hospice of Central Georgia, an inpatient hospice house. Medcen has also supported millions of dollars in research and education grants, acquiring new technologies, and expanding health programs for the citizens of central Georgia.

Cullinan made it her goal to serve as a catalyst and bring the right people together, whether it was volunteers, colleagues, board members or donors to achieve the aforementioned successes. Her strategy built momentum for a cause, and when the force grew stronger, countless donors began to altruistically and generously give to the Foundation.

"Our patients, their families and countless community supporters have been unselfishly charitable with their resources, thus ensuring we have the best hospital possible."

She doesn't take the donors for granted, nor her colleagues and Foundation volunteers, all of whom she said made her successful.

"To be able to work in an environment where, by nature, the people are unbelievably smart and where we do good for the community has been an absolute gift and blessing."

But it took her gifts – one of which was unparalleled passion – to make central Georgians understand and appreciate the incredible health care resource and economic driver that exists in their community.

They're dedicated to their families, they're dedicated to their patients, they're also dedicated to the organization. Who you ask are "they"? They are physicians who are part of Central Georgia Cancer Care, LLC. They are the physicians who as a group made a conscious decision to donate a very generous gift to help build the new Comprehensive Cancer & Research Center.

Twenty two years ago, Dr. Schnell, CEO and President of Central Georgia Cancer Care, LLC, along with his partner at the time, made a decision to move onto the Medical Center of Central Georgia

campus in order to elevate the level of cancer care in Central and South Georgia. They saw an opportunity to positively impact the future of "sophisticated" care and set their sights on achieving their dream of delivering the best cancer care and treatments available.

Unbelievable strides have been made since then. He's seen cancer care move from a mostly inpatient setting to mostly outpatient treatments. This means instead of having an operation and maybe undergoing radiation treatments requiring overnight stays in the hospital, patients now can often undergo their

treatments in a day's time and then go home. As care and treatments have evolved in this direction, so have the requirements for space and the needs of the patients and families. Being a longtime leader in the care of cancer, Dr. Schnell and his group of cancer specialists, now are partnering with the Medical Center to provide the kind of specialized space needed to compliment today's standards of care.

It was nothing less than inspiring listening to several members of Schnell's vital team expressing their enthusiasm for the new Comprehensive Cancer & Research Center which will be located at the corner of Hemlock and First Streets, directly across from the Albert L. "Buddy" Luce Heart Institute. Still in the design phase, it will have up to eight floors with the first four floors housing all outpatient cancer diagnostic and treatment centers, including radiation and chemotherapy. Physician offices will be located on the upper floors. These physicians, all specializing in oncology, are unanimous in the belief that having all services under one roof will be a tremendous benefit to the patients and their families.

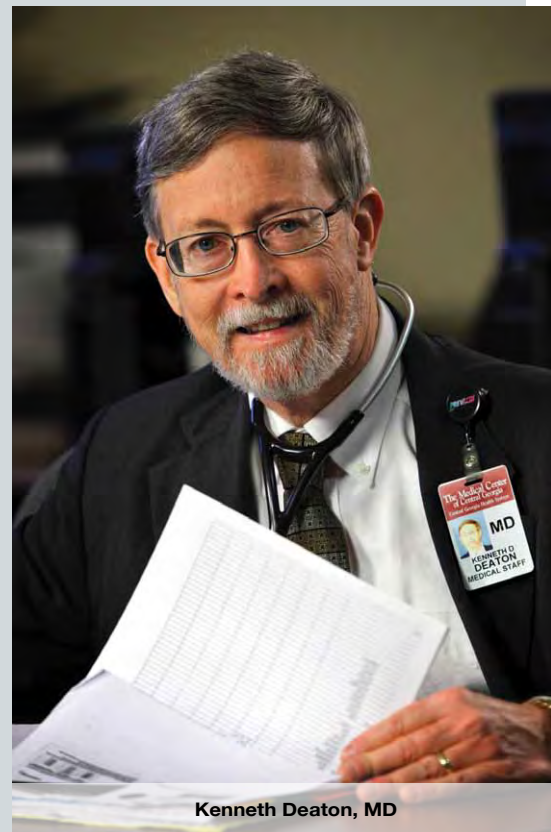
What I found most touching was their sensitivity about the bonds they develop with their patients

and their sincere desire to keep their patients close to home in an atmosphere focused on hope and healing. Repeatedly they voiced the need for patients to be near their families and friends during treatments – it's actually part of the healing process! Among the many benefits this CCRC bring are the nurse navigators who take each patient and family by the hand and steer them through the maze of physician and treatment visits from the day they are diagnosed. They echoed Dr. Schnell's enthusiasm about MCCG's affiliation with the University of Alabama at Birmingham which will open doors to much greater cutting-edge resources than ever before, providing access to second and third opinions without ever having to leave home.

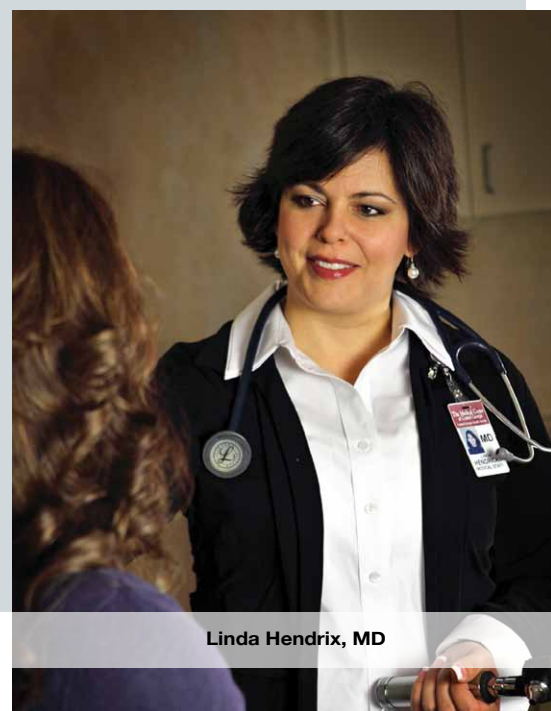

Scott Seigel, Senior Vice President of Branch Banking & Trust (BB&T), Macon, Georgia and Vice Chair of Medcen Community Health Foundation is committed to the mission of his organization, which is to make the community they're in a better place to live. Scott knows well how important top quality health care is to making a community a better place to live. So his decision to make a major gift to Medical Center's campaign to build a Comprehensive Cancer & Research Center (CCRC) was well justified.

Scott's involvement with Medcen began about seven years ago when he happened to meet another Medcen Board member at a totally unrelated event. This "chance" encounter led to a longtime relationship between the Medical Center and BB&T. They started with a major gift to the Luce Heart Institute, then they named a patient room at PinePointe Hospice of Central Georgia, and now their most recent gift will also result in a named room in the new CCRC.

Hospital Hero Award:

Harriette Carter, Trustee of the Medcen Foundation Board, Recipient of Georgia Hospital Association Award

Harriette Carter's path of volunteerism began nearly two decades ago when her sister-in-law, Rene, was placed under hospice care. After experiencing the passion exuded from Hospice of Central Georgia clinical staff and volunteers during an unpleasant time in her family's life, Harriette wanted to share in their kindness and altruism, and decided to become a volunteer.

While working separately as a career placement consultant in the health care industry and in her family business, Harriette spent the next 10 years comforting hospice patients and their families during their difficult moments. She was then asked to serve as a volunteer on the Hospice of Central Georgia Advisory Board, a fundraising branch of the Medcen Community Health Foundation, which, through community-endavors, helps fund services of The Medical Center of Central Georgia. Medcen had just voted to approve a \$5.5 million campaign to fund a free-standing hospice home and needed to raise all the money before groundbreaking.

Harriette's knowledge and passion about Hospice of Central Georgia and her connections within the community made her an easy selection to lead the volunteers' fundraising efforts. She acquired vast knowledge about (the clinical and business aspects of) a successful hospice house, and thus was asked to join the Hospice Capital Cabinet, a board which sought specific donations of \$50,000 or more to the campaign.

When it came time to raise funds, Harriette was one of the first to give. She conversed with friends, family, local businesses and faith-based organizations about donating. She attended every fundraising party, meeting, event and luncheon hosted by Hospice of Central Georgia. No matter the types of persons she met, Harriette could communicate effectively with any of them. Her intuitive sense about people and warm personality made her efforts succeed.

In 2009, the monetary goal was reached, and the free-standing hospice became a reality, but Harriette spearheaded efforts to recruit much-needed volunteers, as law requires a certain percentage of Georgia hospice services must provide care via volunteers. Harriette's volunteer journey came full circle when, at Pine Pointe Hospice 2010 grand opening, she stood in front of a patient room named in memory of Rene, her beloved sister-in-law who died nearly two decades before.

"Because of Harriette's selflessness, dedication, and compassion, we have a hospice that can provide to countless individuals in central Georgia," said Don Faulk, president and CEO of Central Georgia Health System. "She is a shining example of a hero."

Torre Lavelle Raises Funds to Purchase Blanket Warmer for Chemotherapy Patients

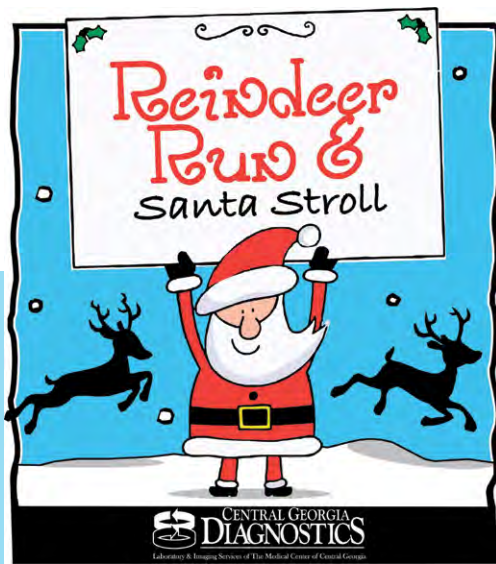

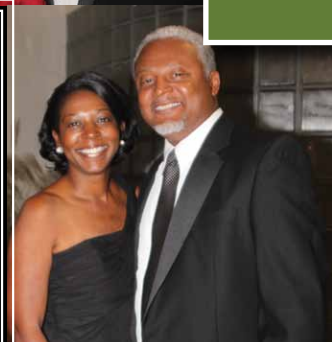

Miracle Child Amare Threatt

Early into her pregnancy, Tyricia Walker of Macon, was sent to Dr. Mark Boddy, a fetal and maternal perinatologist who specializes in high-risk pregnancy. Her situation was dire – the baby maturing inside of her was growing, but with a large tumor the size of his head attached to his neck. Because the tumor was growing along with the baby, at 37 weeks, Tyricia delivered by cesarean section. With baby and mother still attached via umbilical cord, an ex utero intrapartum treatment (EXIT) procedure was performed by a team of subspecialists. (Physicians that made up the team include ENT physicians, pediatric surgeons, a neonatologist, perinatologist and pediatric radiologist.) Immediately the baby had to have his airway secure because the tumor was constricting his ability to breath. The baby was moved to the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit at The Children's Hospital at The Medical Center of Central Georgia to be stabilized. Within two days, pediatric surgeons removed the 13-ounce tumor. Subsequent surgeries have also been performed. Amare is now four months old and is at home with mom and dad.

Had it not been for the expertise of these subspecialists and the services provided by The Children's Hospital and Women's Services at The Medical Center of Central Georgia, Ms. Walker and her baby, Amare, would have had to travel to hospitals in Boston or Philadelphia for these complicated procedures. A surgery of this magnitude is the first for MCCG.

Dealing with the profound grief of losing a loved one is never easy and some people, especially children, may not know how to express their feelings. Through a new program of The Children's Hospital, Bo's Camp, children who have experienced the death of a family member or other significant person in their lives, as well as their parents and guardians, will have the opportunity to learn coping skills and healthy, productive ways of expressing their grief.

The first annual Bo's Camp will be held September 28th-30th at Hephzibah Children's Home in Macon. It will be a three-day, family-centered camp offered free of charge to children 5- 18 years of age and their parents or guardians. Bo's Camp is designed to help children and adults learn to face grief and begin the healing journey. The camp provides an opportunity to meet other families with similar experiences. It is important for families who have lost a loved to know it is okay to smile again, and at Bo's Camp they can learn the skills to reconnect as a family and know it is healing to have fun. Sponsored by The Children's Hospital at The Medical Center of Central Georgia, Bo's Camp is staffed with a trained group of professionals who provide small group sessions to encourage campers to share memories of their loved ones and learn healthy coping skills.

Bo's Camp is an outreach service of the **HUGS (Helping Understanding Guiding & Support)** program of The Children's Hospital. HUGS is a palliative care resource which provides support and care for children and their families with chronic medical conditions or life limiting illnesses.

The name and the spirit of Bo's Camp are based upon the life of Bo Berg, a 3 month old child cared for by The Children's Hospital. Bo is the son of James and Valli Berg and little brother of Molly. In September of 2011, Bo suffered an accidental traumatic head injury which led to his death.

For families like the Bergs, this camp fulfills a mission and a need in our region. A part of our mission is to offer an outreach service to grieving children and their families after the death of a loved one. Bo's Camp offers a safe place for campers to explore their feelings and share experiences with others their age, in a professional, compassionate, and family-centered environment which will enhance the healing process.




Remembering Greta May Allen

United in Pink was originally founded as Bunko for Breast Cancer in May 2005. It began as a fundraiser hosted by a local survivor as an outreach and token of appreciation to the caregivers and community that supported her during her battle with breast cancer.

In 2007, Bunko for Breast Cancer incorporated and became a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. Its mission was to support the entire family affected by a breast cancer diagnosis.

In June 2011, the organization changed its name to United in Pink to better represent its mission. United in Pink strives to increase survivorship and strengthen families affected by a breast cancer diagnosis. Its offerings seek to positively affect the quality of life of survivors, their spouses and children by addressing their psychological, relational, physical and educational needs.

Key activities include, but are not limited to: monthly survivorship workshops, quarterly family socials, distribution of educational materials to families and healthcare professionals, increased collaboration with local organizations, hospital and medical offices, increased speaking engagements to survivors to improve health literacy, continued support for all patients regardless of stage of disease, demographics and financial capabilities and continuation of survivorship care from date of diagnosis until end of life.

United in Pink continues to expand its presence into new communities by partnering with other organizations and companies.

United in Pink currently serves patients in over 10 counties throughout Central Georgia and offers all services at no charge. The organization's largest fundraiser continues to be its annual Bunko for Breast Cancer gathering held each February. In 2011, the event raised \$65,000. United in Pink has further expanded its fundraising efforts and raises over \$90,000 each year to cover the costs of its programs and services.

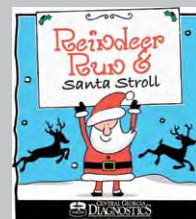
