How does it work?

Community Virtual Primary Care combines an in-person experience with video visit technology. That means you can expect our care team to assist you in-person when you visit, and we'll use state-of-the-art assessment tools during your video visit with one of our remote providers. This innovative care model enables the provider to assess your ears, nose, throat, heart, lungs and skin using advanced technology. An Atrium Health Navicent clinical staff member is onsite assisting you and the remotely located provider throughout the visit. Laboratory testing is completed if needed and a diagnosis and treatment plan are created. The provider will send your prescriptions to your local pharmacy.

How much does it cost?

Depending on your insurance plan, you may be responsible for copays and deductibles related to these services. If you do not have insurance, financial help may be available. There are no upfront charges.
